Other furniture and amenities will be brought to the room as member usage expands and our budget allows. Some of the current ideas presented have been an additional flat screen TV, music, and soft lounge furniture.
2. A snack golf cart will be on the course on Saturdays and Sundays. Hours of service will depend on the number of players on the course.
3. A snack bar at the pool. Ideas are being presented to the POA Board and your Club Committee. Suggestions range from building a snack bar to delivering from the Clubhouse, and vending machines. A plan will be approved and commence in the next few weeks.
4. Some non-fried items will be added to the menu. Meetings will be held with food vendors, restaurant managers and consultants to determine what our kitchen facilities can best offer our customers.
5. A children's menu will be designed.
